

National citizens from the following countries do not require visa to enter Colombia

“Article 1 of Resolution 5707, issued by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs on November 5th 2008, establishes that national citizens from the following countries do not require visa to enter and remain temporarily in Colombia, under the categories of Tourist Visitor, Temporary Visitor and Technical Visitor: Germany, Andorra, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Australia, Austria, The Bahamas, Barbados, Belgium, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Brunei, Bhután, Canada, Chile, Cyprus, Costa Rica, Croatia, Denmark, Dominica, Ecuador, El Salvador, Estonia, Fiji, , Finlandia, France, French Guiana, Grenada, Greece, Guatemala, Honduras, Hong Kong, Hungary, Indonesia, Ireland, Iceland, Israel, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Marshall Islands, Mexico, Micronesia, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Palau, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Dominican Republic, Romania, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Samoa, San Marino, Santa Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Solomon Islands, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom and North Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay, Vatican City and Venezuela. Additionally, Resolution 0928 of March 2009, establishes that Russian citizens who want to visit Colombia do not require visa.”
